- Note: You need to transpose the piccolo part (in C): Mvt VI. Samuel Goldenberg und Schmuyle) into A piccolo/up a minor third....first note is a C on A piccolo.
- Those who do not have a piccolo may play "Mvt <u>VI. Samuel Goldenberg und Schmuyle"</u>
 on Bb or C. If not possible, skip this excerpt on the audition.
- Please play excerpt #9 ("Mvt <u>VI. Samuel Goldenberg und Schmuyle")</u> without a mute. I
 will provide a piccolo straight mute for rehearsal and the performance next semester.
- The last page includes a transposed version of the Mussorgsky "Promenade" and the Samuel Goldenberg und Schmuyle."
