Auditions will be held on Sunday, August 19th from 2:30-4pm in Rosen Concert Hall. Order will be determined at 2:15pm and auditions will be conducted behind a screen.

In presenting a thoroughly prepared and thoughtful audition, I will expect you have done the following:

- Listened and studied multiple recordings of each excerpt (all are available on Youtube, Spotify, iTunes, etc.)
- Practiced SLOWLY, carefully and methodically with a metronome
- Recorded your practicing to evaluate your progress
- Prepared to the point that you know you will play well at your audition

This audition will be for placement into ASO, Wind Ensemble or Symphony Band. <u>Please note that ALL</u> <u>students registered for applied lessons MUST perform an audition</u>. One student will be placed into the Symphony Orchestra, two-three in the Wind Ensemble and the remainder will be placed into Symphonic Band.

The material for this semester's audition is as follows:

- Major scales in ALL KEYS, performed in sixteenth-notes (Quarter note=80), two octaves where possible
- Sight-Reading
- A.Wilder, Suite No.1 for Tuba and Piano, Mvt.V: "Effie Goes Folk Dancing"

- G.Gershwin, An American in Paris
 - Three before Rhl.16-Rhl.17
 - Four after Rhl.67-Rhl.68
 - Four before Rhl.73-Rhl.74
- V.Ewald, Quintet No.1, Mvt.I
 - All

- · Beautiful tone
- Thorough preparation
- Good musicianship




