

I'm Tall, I'm Small

I'm tall, I'm ver - y tall; I'm small, I'm ver - y small; Some - times I'm tall, Some -
times I'm small: Guess what I am now.

Form a circle with one person in center, eyes covered. Choose a leader to decide whether to be tall or small. All stretch up very tall, when singing "I'm tall, I'm very tall" and crouch down making themselves as small as possible for singing "I'm small, I'm very small."

When the leader gives the signal, all take tall or small positions and retain it while the center player guesses. Center player chooses another person to take his or her place.
